

Perambulation of Barrington and Madbury Town Line

The Selectmen of Barrington and Madbury met Nov 22, 1958.

Starting at the bound that makes the bound of Madbury, Lee, Barrington at Wesley Pierce's field, a split rock marked B,L,M, and dated 1857. Thence to the Nute Road, (sometimes referred to as Drew Road) a field stone about 10 feet above the road on left side going toward Madbury, marked BM and dated 1878 & 1906. Then to bound on Hayes Road, a cut stone located at left side of driveway leading to Hayes Lot and about 10 feet off the road market BM dated 1885-1899-1906. The bound could not be located on the Concord Road. It is believed to have been covered up when road was rebuilt. Thence to the marker on Green Hill Road marked B.M.D. for the towns of Barrington, Madbury and Dover, located on the right side of the road going from Dover toward Barrington. The marker being a stone about 15 feet off the road.
