Agritourism Bill Discussion:

The New Hampshire Senate is considering a new agritourism bill that would create a formal statewide definition of agritourism. Local definitions and regulations would be removed.

The Chair reviewed with the board a podcast he listened to in regards to the bill. The chair drafted a potential planning board consensus letter to New Hampshire representatives prior to receiving the amendment. The board agreed the Chair should send a letter voicing the board's opinion on the bill.

Zoning Discussion: agricultural/residential, housing diversity:

The Chair would like to get an idea if the board is interested in a formal discussion on zoning topics that have briefly been discussed at past meetings. Member Sterndale suggested this be a conversation to review with the future consultant.

Member Sterndale shared with the board a draft of the Selectmen's Report. The end of the report discusses the possibility of zoning changes. The board discussed the different zoning changes that may be appropriate for Madbury.

- There is a reference in building regulations that 6 feet of bedrock is needed for test pits. The State is saying 4 feet is needed. Ordinances have been changed to match that.
