Mr. Avery,

Thank you for your e-mail on SB 412, relative to agritourism. Senator Giuda is glad to hear feedback as to how this bill will affect municipalities.

Senator Giuda wanted me to pass along his amendment on SB 412 (see attached) that would replace everything in the introduced version. This amendment does not alter the definition of agritourism, but takes the ability to define agritourism out of local hands and creates an appeal process directly to the Commissioner of Agriculture. This amendment was offered at the Senate Ways & Means Committee. More work will be needed on Section 3 of the amendment, but Senator Giuda wanted the Madbury Planning Board to know that SB 412 is being revised.
