Thank you for the opportunity to review the proposed amendments to the Town of Madbury Aquifer and Wellhead Protection District. As you know, the City of Dover does have public supply wells and additional protective zones within the Town of Madbury. We have reviewed the existing and proposed amendments to the Madbury Aquifer and Wellhead Protection District regulations, and find them to be consistent with the City of Dover's requirements and with those suggested by NHDES. We do not have any objections to the proposed amendments.

We ask that the Board and Town continue to hold development within the groundwater protection zone to high standards through the conditional use process. In particular, we hope that you will look closely at operations that occur at or below the groundwater table that could impact the quality or quantity of the aquifer.

Unfortunately, due to a schedule conflict, I will not be able to participate in the January 6th public meeting, but did want to express Dover's agreement with the regulation amendments.
