- Master Plan Update Committee offered a poster board for residents to offer anonymous inputs during 2017 Madbury Day. Inputs are summarized below.

- Lower taxes (x2)
- Secede from ORCSD equals lower taxes
- Improve intersections of 155 and Town Hall Road / Madbury Road (x4)
- Doggie bags and trash cans for dog walkers at Kingman Farm and Madbury Woods (x2)
- Traffic calming – keep / make roads safe for walkers and bicyclists
- Playground
- Cost of new library

- Master Plan Update Committee request inputs for the Master Plan in the May 2017 Madbury Musings. Inputs are summarized below.

- Like the rural/agricultural feel surrounded by great resources
- Tax burden (including school taxes) is a significant issue
- Find ways to raise revenue without raising residents' taxes. Use Madbury's resources to lessen property tax burden – raise taxes on Kingman Farm and or Portsmouth water facilities, sustainably harvest wood from town forests, etc.
- Cooperate with surrounding towns more. For example Lee transfer station and Durham library, police, fire etc.
- Figure out how to make the town as sustainable as possible.
